### OLD BUSINESS

- Trailer
  - Second Gear Club is interested in purchasing our trailer. Not a confirmed plan yet but Jeff would like pictures.
  - Cheque to be written out for the new trailer
- Club rules
  - Amber went over club rules for harescrambles, Tabletop and General Rules of Conduct.  
**Rules will be posted on the Rocky Motorcycle Club website.**
  - Add to rule 28 that Club executive has authority to make the decision on class
  - Copy rules 16 – 19 from harescrambles to motocross as well
- **\*\*Harescramble New rules\*\***
  - All riders must complete 1 full lap to qualify for points. Rocky Motorcycle Club races run for 90 min for adult classes, 60 min for kids and ladies and 30 min for peewee. If you choose to stop before the time clock has run out you MUST NOT cross the finish line until the time runs out. You will park your bike in the designated pull off area and wait until the end of the race. At that time, you will be permitted to cross the line and finish the race. If you cross the line you are committing to another lap. Failure to complete that lap will result in a DNF.
  - Starting the race in the incorrect starting class will result in a DNF
  - Dustin would like no pit riding added as a rule, 1<sup>st</sup> gear to start. Penalties will be to official's distraction
  - Alex motions approval of new club rules, Dustin seconds. All in Favor.
- Triple Threat Throwdown
  - Amber went through details on the poster
  - Poster will be available on the website when ready
- TFA's
  - BBQ and TFA instruction meeting Sunday May 6 at 2:00 pm at Brian and Stacey's acreage. Everyone is welcome to attend, bring bikes. Moto Tally test will be done as well. Offroad Committee can take a look at race results and vote on bump ups.
- MX Inspection Date
  - MX committee is scheduled to do the inspection Thursday evening at 6:30pm. If all goes well, could be open on Saturday.

## NEW BUSINESS

- Race date changes
  - June 24<sup>th</sup> Marble Mountain race is removed
  - Sharing the Marble Mountain weekend with Second Gear Club. August 18<sup>th</sup> is the Second Gear Club's race and August 19<sup>th</sup> is RMC
  - Gloomy is now August 26<sup>th</sup> instead of the rain date
- Race Names
  - Come up with catchy race day names
  - Amber and Courtney are coming up with a themed race event, details to follow
- Harescramble Series (some changes)
  - Ladies B, Kids A,B – 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM
  - Ladies A will now run the same course as Adult C at 9:00 AM – 10:30 AM
  - Pee wee A, B, C stays the same (30 min races, classes split as needed) 11:00 AM – 12:30 PM
  - Adult A, B, Vet A, B – 1:00 – 2:30 PM
  - Adult AA added for a longer period – 1:00 – 3:00 PM
    - Will allow adult A be more competitive and help bottlenecking
  - Stacey Motions approval of harescramble series. Mike seconds. All in favor.
- RMC Motocross Race Classes and Schedule
- Amber went through RMC Motocross Race Classes
  - 12 min lap for regular class, Intermediate 15 min lap, Pee wee 3 laps
  - Keep pros to the end so people stay to spectate
  - Tentative schedule B until registration then can Look at race schedule
  - Age limit 12+ for ATV. May split depending on skill level and rider numbers that show up
  - Stacey motions to approve motocross race class changes. Mark seconds. All in favor.
- Ice racing
  - Marilyn with CMA emailed wants to look at ice racing classes to see if any classes should be removed.
  - Discussion resulted in leaving classes as is and see next year if more riders show up for these classes
  - Amber motions 3 UTV classes 899 stock and under, 900-999 naturally aspirated and down, 1000+. Mark seconds. All in favor.
  - Add an open Woman's class UTV
  - Need to check seat belts prior to starting race

- Stacey motions rules to be added. Doors have to be bolted on so body weight will hold through net, lanyard 18" solid material not coils. Rear bright light mounted 4 feet or higher from ground. Kevin seconds. All in favor.
- Moto-tally and Online Registrations – Hare Scrambles Only
  - In process of setting up a PayPal account for membership payments. PayPal has a 2.9% + \$0.30 charge per transaction.
  - Can run online pre-registration for races once member has received an email that they are approved for the series and memberships are paid. Stacey approves bike numbers and class sign up and will send an email back.
  - If there are unforeseen circumstances ex. rain out, sick, bike broken there are no refunds for online pre-payments
  - People with free memberships will have to email or phone Stacey for a code to pre-register online
  - Still need to sign waivers on race day. Waivers will be pre filled out, packages waiting at registration table
  - Registration will be open two weeks before event and closed on the Thursday prior to the event
  - Anyone who has already signed up for memberships will have to be manually put into Moto-Tally by Natasha, Christine and Stacey.
  - **Bike numbers are first come first serve and there will be no double numbers in the whole club, this will be their number for the whole season.**
  - Stacey motions to do online registration utilizing PayPal. Amber agrees for the 2018/19 season and see how it goes. Nathan seconds. All in favor.
  - Kendra Braun may be able to train on running the Moto-Tally system alongside Stacey
