OLD BUSINESS

- No Boyz Clinic Recap
 - Clinic went very well. Even with some people that backed out, were able to fill up the workshop
 - Great reviews, riders are already asking when the next one will be
- Day Pass Pricing
 - Discussion around changing the day pass rate for the rest of the year
 - Stacey motions to keep the \$40.00 day pass. Alex seconds. All in Favor.
- Ricinus Fun Day
 - Team fun day went over very well, all the reviews were outstanding.
 - Some complaints about cost. Look at having the Ricinus Fun day to be no cost next year possibly.
- Ricinus Race
 - Race went well other than flagging torn down causing some confusion
 - Discussion around “DNF” if you cross the scanning tent and do not complete next lap. Rules were applied at the beginning of the year stating if you choose to stop before the time clock has run out you must not cross the finish line until the time runs out. You will park your bike in the designated pull off area and wait until the end of the race. At that time, you will be permitted to cross the line and finish the race. If you cross the line you are committing to another lap. Failure to complete that lap will result in a DNF. Riders who disagree with this rule should attend the meeting at the beginning of the year to voice opinions and have this altered.
 - Please remember to let the lap scoring tent know that you were a DNF so sweepers are not out looking for riders that went home
- ERP
 - Brian received the ERP from Second Gear Club. He will be reviewing this and modifying as necessary
- Safety Supplies
 - Check first aid kit, and location. Wall mount rack, fire axe, couple shovels, couple of rakes. Make sure fire extinguishers are in the trailer. Fueling station. Should have a sign on trailer stating, “First Aid Kit Inside” and “Fire Extinguisher Inside”. Kevin was going to get quote for us, need to follow up with him.
 - Purchase of safety whistles. Amber motions purchasing 350 whistles at \$1.50 each. Courtney seconds. All in favor.
 - Alex motions purchase of radios and base station with \$700 budget. Amber Seconds. All in Favor.

- Water tanks
 - Ask Mark to see if there is any progress on the repair of the water tank and if anyone is willing to take this on.
- AOTMX Race Recap
 - Alberta Old Timers Motocross. Event went well, some issues with garbage not being picked up. Track should always be left in the same condition it was in at arrival.
- Round 2 MX Recap
 - 74 race entries and 1 minor injury. Reasonable spectator turnout. No suspensions or people asked to leave. Day flowed smooth and only one minor time was reduced for the afternoon moto's to get through the day. Over all a success.
- Jason Schrage Clinic
 - Clinic went very well, next year Rocky Club can advertise this ahead of time to allow more participants. The clinic is easy for beginner riders, they just have to show up as Jason has all the gear and bikes available for them.
- August Day Pass Weekend Recap
 - August day pass weekend went well. The energy was great and there were quite a few riders there. Most riders were members, which showed the day pass weekends were doing their job for selling memberships.
- New Gate
 - New Gate is fixed and working great at the track
- Marble and Gloomy TFA
 - Both the Marble and Gloomy TFA are submitted

NEW BUSINESS

Succession Planning for Next Year

- There are many key volunteers and positions that will be vacant next year. President and possibly Vice President, board positions, race organizers, mototally / scoring etc. Many of these positions will be best to have training for the rest of the season for successful events next year
- Amber has put together a list of all responsibilities for MX race day, someone will need to take ownership of these MX races going forward. Discussion around having a group of key volunteers to help with these events so it is not all on one person. We will require someone to train alongside with Amber for the next MX race. Please voice your interest asap!
- Stacey is training Natasha in Mototally now, but we will need more volunteers to learn the system as this is a lot of work for one person.

Off-Road

- Marble Joint Second Gear Club Race
 - CMA races will be held on the Saturday
 - Sunday will be Kids, Ladies, PeeWees, Adult Classes. Second Gear Club classes to join in on the Sunday.
 - Stay tuned for schedule details, schedule will be adjusted due to long race course
 - There will be 4 live check points, including a gas at 3rd check point. Need one biker for a check point and 3 trucks for the others.
 - Some flagging done, more is required
 - Dustin will pickup radios for the race at Oras
- Gloomy Race
 - Going well, TFA is in. Few people have been out there to ride the loops. More details to follow in upcoming weeks.

- Osbourne's
 - No riding is permitted outside of race times
 - Absolutely no dogs allowed

MX

- Track Grooming

- General Repairs

 - Discussion around sun shelter over the bleachers at the track. Shelters will allow a better environment for spectators. Amanda Jardine is getting a quote on sun shades for all three bleachers.
 - Amber is going to paint the highway sign rather than replace it
