Agenda item: MX

Discussion:

- Radio's
 - 2 down, 4 left
 - Cost for new is \$240.00
 - Wes Shippelt motions for the purchase of 2 new radio's
- Flaggers/Sweepers
 - Use a non-profit organization to supply flaggers for MX events
 - Flagger's left posts abandoned after 6pm.
 - 17 posts
 - Discussed donation of \$100/post for 8am – 6pm.
 - 17 posts @ \$100.00/post = \$1700.00 for flaggers
 - If the event runs past 6pm a bonus of \$300.00 if all flaggers remain in their designated posts.
 - Sub for posts are fine as long as they are provided and not club members.
 - Tarren Pidherney motions approval for the discussed donation
- First Event = 285 entries
- Lap Scoring
 - Currently manual lap score
 - Lap scoring issues – currently none of the lap scoring matches one another
 - Mototally could be used for MX events, transponders could also be used to prevent discrepancies
- Transponders
 - Discussed the use of the transponders
 - MX Race in Canada uses transponders
 - Club buys everything for 1 year at a cost of \$8000.00

- Transponders are ready for order
- Discussed the purchase of 30 transponders for use/sale to members
- Transponders could be sold to members at a discounted rate
- Cost for membership \$100.00 + Cost for transponders \$100.00
- Can MyLaps and transponders be used for Ice Racing?
- Stick to the 30min time allotment for complaints.
- Discussed possible addition of classes
 - +25 A/B
 - +40 A/B (old timers have to be a certain age)
 - MX1/MX2 (juniors)
 - Decision: not feasible for the day to have extra classes – time is already a crunch.
- Extra parking
 - Absolutely no parking on the road – currently an active logging road
 - Extra parking provided and to be used
- Race officials for 2nd MX event
 - West Shippelt “race official”
 - Matt Langford “pit official”
- Sandwich boards in C-can to be used for posting “Spectator Event”
- Velocity hydrovac supplying water truck and driver for 2nd MX event.
- ACR Rentals – mini hoe Friday night for water repair, culverts, pipes, etc.
- Pit Riding
 - Strict adherence for pit riding
 - Discussed automatic position or time docking for anyone caught pit riding
 - Pit riding without helmets even non-participants will result in participant consequences
